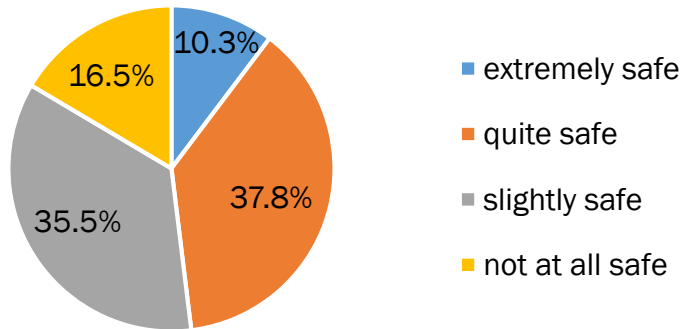
Question: How safe do you consider your neighborhood to be?

Not at all safe	16.5%

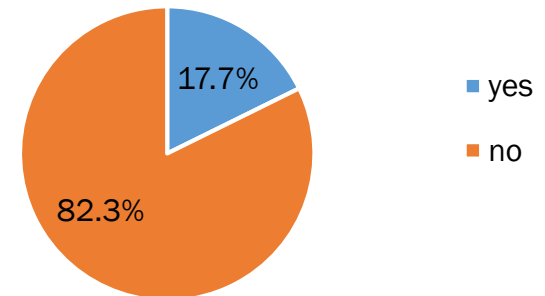
Question: Have you or a member of your household been a victim of a crime in your neighborhood in the past 12 months?

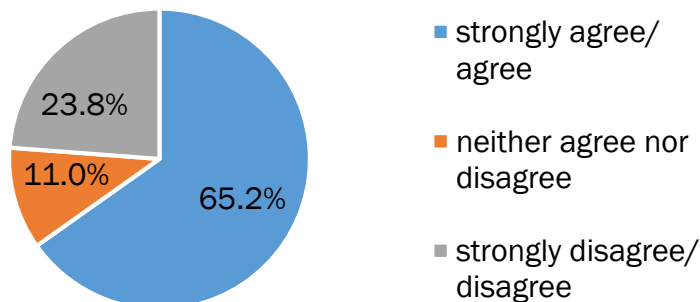
Question: There are safe places for me and my family to be physically active in my neighborhood

Strongly disagree/ disagree	23.8%

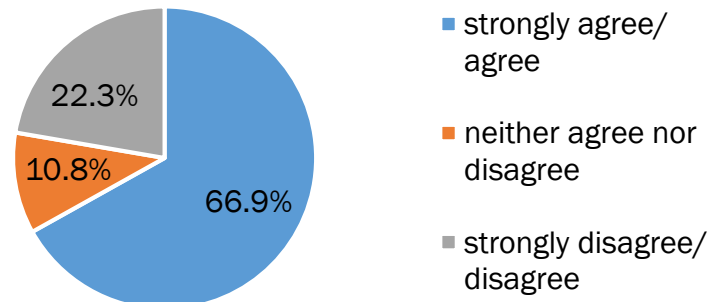
Question: I am satisfied with the quality of life that my neighborhood provides
